PRINCE OF ASCOT showed speed from the inside, was a factor on the turn and vied through the stretch but was no match for the winner. RANDOM PAY CHECK was in mid pack, saved ground on the turn and was up for show. BIT OF A MOOD had early speed and was hustled along on the turn but from the three path through the stretch evened out. MISSISEE had no speed, raced evenly on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. BANKER LARRY was in range and roused from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch leveled off. CLAYMIESTER was off the pace and raced from the four path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no impact. ACE IN MY POCKET stumbled just after the break and showed nothing while outrun.
