MADAME ARABELLA trailed early, circled the field on the far turn and took command from the three path through the stretch and was impressive. IMPERIAL KISS was in range and had a mild gain on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was second best. O'DELLE was off the pace, roused from the four path on the far turn, angled to the inside at the top of the stretch and was up for show. NOT A COALITION was in mid pack and hustled along on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch evened out. DASH OF THE BEST stalked the leader and saved ground on the far turn but from the four through the stretch weakened. SCOTTS RIVAL was in touch early but trailed the field on the far turn and was outrun. SUPREME PROSPECT showed speed and set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn but dropped back through the stretch.
