TOCCET MAN set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn, raced from the four path at the top of the stretch and with pressure in deep stretch prevailed. BATHSHEBA STATION stalked the leader and was a factor on the turn but from the five path through the stretch just missed. EL GRAYLING stumbled at the start, gained ground from the inside on the turn and finished well in deep stretch. BURI showed no speed and was hustled along on the turn but from the six path through the stretch evened out. KIRBINATOR was well back, showed nothing and failed to fire. NOT SO GRIEM was hustled from the outside but chased on the turn and from the seven path at the top of the stretch had nothing left.
