Footnotes

LITTLE MISERY forced the pace, moved inside STORMPROOF midway through the final turn, dueled to the top of the stretch and wore that one down then held sway under light handling. LAVERLOCHERE stalked the pace, finished willingly along the rail. STORMPROOF set a pressured pace, drew clear briefly on the backstretch, entertained a challenge on the far turn, stayed gamely to the top of the stretch and yielded. KISSME I'M GONE saved ground, never reached contention. WAYNE'S MIRACLE moved to the rail midway through the clubhouse turn, edged closer while in hand on the backstretch but lacked a response when asked on the far turn. PELUQUITA (ARG) was always outrun.
