T C MAIDEN settled off the pace and between foes on the turn, angled out in early stretch, bid outside the leaders then was up in time to prevail. HARVEST SINGING dueled for the lead and had pressure inside and out, shook clear in the stretch then was caught late in a good try. MOONLITE WALK moved early from the inside to vie into the turn, battled into the stretch then weakened against the top two. EMPTOR backed off after dueling for the early lead, stalked on the turn then evened out. ORO CALIENTE had a mild close from off the rail after trailing for a half. PANIEMONIAM off the pace and saving ground, lacked the needed kick. PIERSIXER was steadied at the break then failed to fire from off the pace. CITI MUSIC dueled briefly while 4-wide then backed away and faded.
