STORMEY WONDER was up close, a factor on the turn, had the lead from the three path at the top of the stretch and was much the best. ROCK A TONG stalked the leaders, had a good position on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was no match for the winner. CENT T MINT was unhurried early, roused from the three path on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was up for a share. OUT OF SESSION was off the pace, saved ground on the turn and had a mild gain through the stretch. NESSUN DORMA was in touch and hustled along from the inside on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no impact. GLORIOUS MELODY was off slowly and showed nothing in a dull effort. BLACK NAPKINS set the pace and duled on the turn but dropped back through the stretch.
