**Footnotes**

ALPHABET KID showed speed, had mild pressure on the far turn and with a clear lead in mid stretch prevailed. NORTHERN MONARCH was unhurried early, moved up from the five path on the far turn and from the eight path at the top of the stretch closed. SARGEANT OF ARMS was well back, gained ground on the far turn from the inside and finished well. DREAM IT was in range and had a good position on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch evened out. ELLIS CASTLE had no speed and was hustled hard on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no response. FATHER NORM was in touch and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch lacked a rally. READY ROADSTER was off the pace, raced from the three path on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch failed to fire. CAIT'S APPLE JACK forced the early pace, chased from the inside on the far turn and came up empty. BIDDIE'S FOLLY was in mid pack and backed away on the far turn in a dull effort. I'M A WANTED MAN was a factor early and was roused on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was outrun.
