CARLAS EXPRESS showed speed, took command on the far turn and was kept to task while all out through the stretch. DIXIE JET was in range, gained ground on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. PERFETTO ROSA was unhurried early and moved up from the three path on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch needed more. WOMANS BAY had no speed and saved ground on the far turn but evened out through the stretch. BRIGHT FORTUNE forced the pace, chased on the far turn and from the three path through the stretch faded. SAMANTHA'S STAR was in touch early but trailed the field on the far turn in a dull effort. PROUDLY TRUE reared at the start, showed nothing and failed to fire.
