TRUE DESTINY was in mid pack, roused on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was up in time. NOT FOO LING stalked the leaders, was a factor on the turn and led from the five path at the top of the stretch but just missed while finishing on the rail in deep stretch. EXCELLENCY was bumped at the start, had mild gain from the inside on the turn and finished well through the stretch. LOVE NEEDS LUCK was in mid field and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch needed more. COOL VIBRATIONS broke inward and forced the pace on the turn but faded through the stretch. KNIGHT OF ASCOT showed no speed and trailed the field on the turn while not a factor. D'LUCKY CAT set a pressured pace and had a slim lead on the turn but from the four path through the stretch was empty. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON EXCELLENCY AGAINST TRUE DESTINY AND COOL VIBRATIONS FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE AT THE START WAS NOT ALLOWED.
