SEMINARIAN was in touch, gained ground on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was up in time. BEWARE OF THE SON was off the pace, hustled hard from the inside on the turn and rallied but just missed. BLUSHING NOODLE had speed from the outside, dueled on the turn and had the lead in mid stretch but was outfinished. FORTIUS was off slow and had a mild gain from the inside on the turn but needed more through the stretch. PRESIDENTIAL was hustled early and forced the pace on the turn but faded late. BEARS NORTHERN was in range and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch had no late kick. ASYMMETRIC was up close and chased from the inside on the turn but from the three path through the stretch weakened. TROUBADOR SONG had no speed and saved ground on the turn but was never a threat. KOKOMO KID was unhurried early, showed nothing and was not a factor.
