Footnotes

ELORA tracked the leader briefly then moved between foes and led on the turn, kept on the engine while under good urging in an off the rail drive. CUSTOMS in mid field and on the inside into the turn, closed then rallied between foes in the drive to finish willingly. BLUSHING BARBIE came from off the pace while in the 5-path on the turn to get it into gear entering mid stretch and rally between foes. CASE OF PRIDE had speed to lead early then was done early and gave way from the rail. ICE PELLET was up close early and 3-wide while pressing, tracked the winner on the turn then lacked the needed finish. SONG OR PSALM had a belated run from the trailing spot but did not menace. SAILOR'S DREAM raced wide, off the pace and was never a serious threat.
