Footnotes

JUST LIKE BOO was up close, forced the pace on the turn and with the lead at the top of the stretch proved best. JENNY'S MAGIC stumbled at the start, gained ground on the turn and finished well in deep stretch. WEDDING PROMISE showed speed, set the pace and vied at the top of the stretch but faded late. CURVE OF SPEE was in mid field and had a mild gain from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch was all out. ABERFORTH had no speed, was a factor from the inside on the turn but from the four path through the stretch evened out. LITTLE MISS PRISS stalked the leaders from the outside but chased from between foes on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch weakened. BELIEVE YOU ME was off the pace and roused from the three path on the turn but had no response. STAR DISCOVERY was well back, showed nothing and failed to fire. HAGGAT HALL was in mid pack but lost ground on the turn and was outrun.
