WHO WE GUNNA CALL was in mid pack, moved up from the three path on the far turn, was a factor at the top of the stretch and proved best. WELLOILEDMACHINE was in range, had a slim lead on the far turn and vied through the stretch but was outgunned. NORTHERN MAGIC showed speed, dueled into the far turn and chased at the top of the stretch while all out. HARDROAD TO HEAVEN showed no speed, had a mild gain on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch evened out. PEACH OF A DAY was up close and hustled along from the inside on the far turn but had no impact. COOL GATOR was in touch and chased into the far turn but was not a factor. BANKURA was off the pace and trailed the field on the far turn in a dull effort.
