CHIA HOUA HOUA set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn and widened under light handling through the stretch. LUCKY NED was in range and moved up from between foes on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch was second best. MISHMASH was off the pace and hustled along from the three path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was all out. POWER GRID was in touch and roused from the inside on the far turn but had no finish. AWAKE BY NOON was off slow and had a mild gain from the four path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch had no impact. ASCENDING SON was in mid pack and trailed the field on the far turn while not a factor. FIRSTIMAGE stalked the leader early but lost ground on the far turn and failed to fire.
