Footnotes

TETHRA'S WORD stalked from the outside, was a factor from the three path on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch proved best. CHA CHA FOR NOW was in mid field, hustled from the inside on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for place. BAILEY'S RING was up close and dueled from between foes on the turn but evened out. SOAR was in mid pack and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path through the stretch needed more. SEXY MADE SIMPLE was hustled early and roused on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no response. CENT T MINT was well back, trailed the field on the turn and had no impact. STILL SHARP had no speed and showed little while not a factor. DUETTINA set the pace but was pressured on the turn and dropped back through the stretch.
