DAVERICK set the pace, was pressured at the top of the stretch, took command and was much the best. CHILKOOT PASS stalked, pressed the leader at the top of the stretch but was no match and second best. SLATED PROMISE was back early, raced evenly on the turn and had a mild rally in the stretch. ALL ABOUT MAMA trailed early, five path at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. STUCK IN TRAFFIC was in touch, hustled on the turn and tired late in the drive. SHARING THE LOVE was off the pace, three path on the turn to the four path in the stretch but had no impact. TROUBLE TODAY was up close, backed away into the turn and was no factor. HEAR THE BEAT was in range, roused inside on the turn and flattened out in late stretch.
