KINSTAR set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn and with mild pressure at the top off the stretch prevailed. GRANT'S LOVE was in range, had a mild gain on the far turn and with a good position at the top of the stretch was all out in the drive. VICAR'S VISION had no speed and was roused on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch finished evenly. BELFAST DANCER was back early and moved up on the far turn but from the four path leveled off through the stretch. CATCH THE POSSE was in touch, hustled along from the three path on the far turn and was a factor at the top of the stretch but gave way. DEPUTY LOR was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and passed a tired foe through the stretch. EXCALIBUR forced the pace, lost ground on the far turn and had little impact.
