Footnotes

SIR VIVA stalked the leader early, had the led on the far turn, took command through the stretch and proved best. A DEVILISH RIDE was unhurried early, moved up into the far turn and was a factor at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner in deep stretch. CAT N SASSY was in range and gained ground from the three path on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch was all out. FOOD FOR THOUGHT had no speed and was roused on the far turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no response. WERBLIN'S SUN was in touch and had a mild gain from between foes on the far turn but had no kick from the inside through the stretch. FLAGRANTE DELICTO set the pace but was pressured on the backstretch and came up empty. FOUND THE TREASURE was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and was never in contention.
