Footnotes

PHILLY EXPRESS off the early pace, gained and split foes after going four, angled out in early stretch, bid, led and was kept to task. WAPITOULE in striking distance and 3-wide turning for home, bid from there and rallied well outside. PEACH TREE TEA stalked the speed battle and saved ground then had a mild stretch kick to nail the show spot. FOOTSTEPS dueled between foes and was battling into the stretch then gave way inside in the final furlong. LOVELY MISSY had a late run after trailing on the turn but it had no impact. TRUE REALITY dueled inside, vied through the turn then faltered. NORTHERN BOUNTY stumbled at the break, dueled three wide into the turn, tired after going a half and faded. GOLD'N'COUNTER off the pace and in the five path turning for home, lacked a bid.
