Footnotes

FLYING TABRIZ raced in the middle of the pack, began to close outside rivals leaving the backstretch, came four-wide into the stretch, gained steadily and just got up. CATTLEWASH was hustled after the leader in the early stages, challenged between rivals entering the turn, dueled to the stretch and shook clear then failed to contain the winner in the final strides. KARLEY'S MELODY chased along the rail on the turn, drove between rivals at the head of the stretch but hung in the late stages. KILLALY was hustled early to stay close, bid three-wide entering the turn, lost ground then flattened out in the stretch. BONITA BAY showed speed, set the pace then was joined at the turn, dueled from the rail then tired early stretch. MAWASASPORT raced in the middle of the pack along the rail but lacked a strong closing response. OUT WELL was squeezed back badly just out of the gate, trailed along the rail then showed a mild late run between rivals. JEALOUS LOVER saved ground, was always well back and lacked a rally. LEANDER ROSE broke alertly but faded quickly. R MELODY was through early and faded to the outside.
