D'DUPLICATE broke smartly and led from the outset, held sway throughout and finished off a gate to wire effort. DADY LAWYER on the inside early and in touch, took to the 3-path for the drive, bid but had to settle for best of rest. KRIS'S HONOR in mid field and on the inside turning for home, had a mild rally. CATS ARE TRICKY tracked while outside of foes, kept in the hunt throughout, but lacked a final bid. FLEET FOOT HARRY came from off the pace to put in a late outside run but did not threaten. HOPING FOR GLORY was bumped hard at the break, raced in mid field then finished inside. BALLISTICSTATISTIC chased the speed and was a factor through the turn then weakened. KIT THE CAT trailed early and was never a factor. ONE MORE DAY was well back throughout and showed nothing. ST. ALBERT FOX was bumped hard at the break and was never a factor thereafter.
