SIR VIVA dueled outside of rival then cleared that one after going a half, opened a gap on the field, held sway and proved best under good handling while off the rail. ITSWHATWELIVEFORE on the inside early and in the hunt, angled out to bid wide in the drive then finished it off with a good stretch rally. JON SNOW tracked the speed battle, kept in the game through the turn then evened out in an off the rail run to the wire. CAN'T BE PETE well back early, had a mild gain to be inside for the stretch effort, bid up the rail but it was not enough. FOOD FOR THOUGHT dueled early then chased the winner on the turn while losing ground and tired in the final furlong. DISBELIEF was off the pace from the outset and never did fire. DOWN WITH DIXIE settled in mid pack, lacked a bid and was not a stretch factor. KINNAIRD showed little in an off the pace effort. POINT TUPPER up close and outside early, lost ground then was all done when the stretch arrived.
