SUPREME PROSPECT dueled inside of rival, vied on the turn then failed to match up for the run to the wire but was game to save the place spot. ROSE DREAMS had an outside trip while tracking the speed duel, bid from off the rail and was clear of the rest at the wire. NOT TONIGHT HONEY chased the speed battle, was in the hunt on the turn then lacked a stretch kick. NOT A COALITION was off the pace and never close. JUSTAFEELING was close early, backed off the speed battle then gradually faded from the scene. SCOTT'S RIVAL was off the pace, had no rally and never a menace. UPTOWN RAY trailed throughout and showed nothing.
