VENABLO was off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, roused at the top of the stretch and was going away at the wire. GRANT'S LOVE showed speed inside, had the lead into the far turn, vied through the stretch and fought gamely for place. CATCH THE POSSE showed speed on the outside, forced the pace on the far turn, had a slim lead in upper stretch but tired late. MONEY PLAYER was back early, had a mild gain on the far turn, three path at the top of the stretch and needed more. SKY WARRIOR stalked the leaders, was roused on the far turn, four path at the top of the stretch and leveled off. BEAR'S PRADO was in mid pack, chased while in the five path on the far turn, six path at the top of the stretch and gave way. HOME IN TWO hesitated at the start, trailed and was never in contention. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
