TANGO SHOW trailed early, moved up while in the four path on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and was clear at the wire. PEAKS SQUEEZE was off the pace, gained ground while in the 3-path on the turn, seven path at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. WHATYADO dueled early, had a slim lead in upper stretch and gave way late. DREAM SOCIETY was in mid pack, saved ground on the turn, had a bid at the top of the stretch and closed inside. WITH ALL DILIGENCE was off the pace, had a mild gain on the turn and rallied between foes in the stretch. PERFECT SUSPECT trailed, five path on the turn to the six path at the top of the stretch and rallied belatedly. SKIP THE NIGHT was kept close, vied from the five path at the top of the stretch and leveled off. CATILLAC ONE was in touch, had a good position at the top of the stretch and flattened out late in the drive. FINE EXAMPLE was back early,

hustled into the turn and dropped back in the stretch. TOMAKWA dueled with leaders, vied at the top of the stretch but tired inside. ARCHESS was in range, vied from the three path on the turn and came up empty.
