Footnotes

MISTER DO IT showed speed, had the lead on the turn and with mild pressure at the top of the stretch was kept to task in the drive. BULLET BOY had no speed, closed the gap on the turn and from the four path through the stretch finished well. THEBOYSCANSWIM was in touch and a factor on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch evened out. SABINO was back early and rushed up on the backstretch but from the five path at the top of the stretch weakened. GLADWYNE was off slow, roused from the four path on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch had a mild gain. MYSTIC MISSILE broke awkward and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. A FLEETS ESCAPE had no speed, trailed the field on the turn and from the seven path at the top of the stretch had a dull effort. COPOLA was up close but lost ground on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was not a factor.
