DADDY'S VANY showed speed, had the lead on the turn and with a clear lead through the stretch proved best. FASHION DESIGN was in range and had a good position on the turn but from the three path through the stretch was second best. GROS MORNE was up close, raced evenly from the inside on the turn and held well for show. GOODBAI PATTY was well back, had a mild gain from the four path on the turn, from the seven path at the top of the stretch angled in and closed inside. SISTER FAITH was in touch and roused from the three path on the turn but leveled off in the stretch. BEAU JESS forced the pace and was a factor on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch weakened. DANZIN COZZENE had no speed and was hustled along from the three path on the turn but had no impact. NOBODY TOLD ME hopped at the break, trailed the field on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. LOVE BRACELET was unhurried early and saved ground on the turn but failed to fire. PERFECT SUSPECT was in mid pack, lost ground into the the turn and was outrun.
