Footnotes

BAD BOY WILL kept in touch and was in the 3-path on the turn while tracking the front runner, then kept coming at the leader and arrived in time. TEXAS BLITZ had early speed to open a gap, was in charge into the final furlong then nailed at the wire and missed. FRISKY WHISKEY in mid pack, saved ground then bid inside in the drive and was up for the show. BOLD CORREDOR settled off the pace and then wide into the stretch, had a late outside rally. WILD DIAMOND off the pace, put in a mild bid from off the rail, exchanged bumps in the drive then did not have enough to catch the show spot. STORMY COMET tracked the leader through the turn, came out and exchange bumps with outside rival in the drive and tired. BLACKENBERRY broke awkwardly, trailed and was not a factor. TAHANA in touch in the early going, lost ground and faded. A STEWARDS' inquiry into the exchange of bumps by STORMY COMET and BLACKENBERRY in the stretch resulted in no change in the order of finish.
