**Footnotes**

LOCUST HALL set the pace, was pressured on the far turn, roused at the top of the stretch and was kept to task. BROKEN ENGAGEMENT was off the pace, gained ground between foes on the far turn and just missed. DEPUTY LOR stalked the leader, forced pace far turn, had a bid at the top of the stretch and was outkicked in the drive. DASHING MONTY was kept close, chased while in the four path on the far turn, five path at the top of the stretch and had no kick. DIAMOND MOON was well placed, had good position while inside on the far turn and finished evenly. WHISKEY SPECIAL trailed, four path on the far turn and passed tired foes in the stretch. MOGUL was off the pace, raced evenly while in the four path on the far turn and had no impact. CAN'T BE PETE was well back, had a mild gain in the three path on the far turn and tired in the stretch.
