Footnotes

DESTIND TO PAY was away alertly but settled off the pace, vied from the five path through the stretch and proved best. GIN JOINT was up close, dueled from between foes on the turn and had the lead from the three path in mid stretch but was outfinished. BETTER BELIEVE showed speed from between foes and was a factor from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch gave way late. RENT A FRIEND was hustled early and had a slim lead from the inside on the turn but leveled off through the stretch. JASAMINE COT was off slow, trailed the field on the turn and had no impact. CROWD FAVORITE stumbled at the start and was roused on the turn but from the four path through the stretch had no response. STORMY MARDEN showed early speed but dropped back on the turn and from the six path through the stretch was empty.
