GOLDEN GLADE was unhurried early, hustled along from the four path on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch was up in time. KEEP THE CHIEF was in mid pack, gained ground from the four path on the far turn and had the lead in mid stretch but was outgunned. BINKS FOREST dueled early, had the lead on the far turn and vied through the stretch but was outfinished. COOL KAHUNA showed speed from the inside but lost ground on the far turn and switched to the outside and came again. WILDCAT PRINCE was in range and had a mild gain on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch evened out late. RIMAL AL SAHARA was up close and hustled from the inside on the far turn but weakened late. MODIMO was off slow, trailed the field on the far turn and was not a factor. SOUTHERN LEGEND was in touch and a factor from between foes on the far turn but was empty through the stretch.
