NELLIE B was unhurried early, roused from the the three path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch was up in time. STYLE IN STILETTOS was up close and had a bid from between foes on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch just missed. YONA'S LORE was in touch and a factor from the four path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch was outfinished. BEARS LADY pressed the pace, had a slim lead on the turn and vied through the stretch but gave way late. LET'S GET TO IT was in range and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no kick. MUDDY had no speed and saved ground on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch lacked a late response. MOBILILIA was well back, trailed the field on the turn and failed to fire. I'MGONNABESOMEBODY showed speed and dueled from the inside on the turn but tired in mid stretch.
