RUMBLE RUCKUS was hustled early, set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn and just lasted. MOBY DIP was in touch, had a mild gain from the inside on the turn and rallied through the stretch but just missed. ZENKO was mid pace, moved up from the four path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch gained gradually. FASTER THAN FLASH had no speed and was hustled along on the turn but needed more through the stretch. ALMOSTOUTOFTHEBLUE was off the pace and saved ground on the turn but lacked a serious bid. CROWN OF GLORY was up close and a factor from between foes on the turn but flattened out in the drive. LONE ENDEAVOR was back early, showed little and had no impact. ROLAND'S SWORD stalked the leaders from the outside but chased from the three path on the turn and had nothing left.
