For Fillies and Mares, Three-Year-Olds and Upward, Canadian-Breds. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,000 when making entry, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. Three-Year-Olds 118 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 three times in 2003-2004 allowed 2 lbs. Of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 twice in 2003-2004 allowed 4 lbs. Of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 once in 2003-2004 allowed 6 lbs. Of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 8 lbs. The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2003-2004. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. \$55,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program/Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society. Plus up to \$8,970 Breeder Awards for the 1st., 2nd. and 3rd. place finishers. Nominations closed Thursday, June 17th., 2004 with 11 nominations.

ROMAN ROMANCE in the pack and in striking while at the rear of the field on the turn, bid 4-wide entering the stretch, rallied willingly and was up in time to get the job done. SPANISH DECREE chased the speed then bid outside the leader turning for home, led into the final furlong from off the rail but could not withstand the winner's outside rally. ONTHEQT had speed to lead for a half then was pressured outside and faltered in the drive but held the show spot. TAMARA in touch and 3-wide turning for home, bid but was outfinished while evening out in the late going. LUCKIERTHANUTHINK tracked the speed then lacked a rally. FINNERTY'S FROLIC was bumped at the break, raced inside of foes and lacked a kick.
