**Footnotes**

DANCE KUNTAKETE inside and settled off the pace from mid pack, closed willingly on the far turn, was on the rail entering the stretch, bid from there and the good rally had him up in time. SUPERTRAMP stalked the pacesetters and sat in the catbird's seat, bid on the far turn, battled to the wire but was outfinished with an off the rail try. RAEWANDA kept contact and bid on the far turn, looked a danger, challenged in the drive but was outdone late. PROUD AMERICAN came from well back to close and put in a late 3-path bid. BEACH OF BALI dueled inside and battled into the far turn then faded. KIZZY KAZOO had a belated non-threatening run. MEET IN MIAMI raced in mid pack and off the pace then had no rally. FAFNIR trailed then passed tired ones. ROYAL BRITTANY was off the pace and did not fire. TRULY SPECIAL faded after dueling for five.
