SANS SOUSI was in range, had good position on the turn and with a bid at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. BENT ATTORNEY was back early, hustled along from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch closed. FABRIC was in mid pack and saved ground on the turn but with a bid through the stretch was all out. ARTICULATING was hustled early and had the lead on the turn but from the three path through the stretch was outfinished. SHESADOZER was off the pace and had a mild gain from the four path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch evened out. CLASSY KATHERINE was rushed early and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch leveled off. LADY FORTUNA had no speed, saved ground on the turn and had a mild bid at the top of the stretch but tired late. TENNIS BRACLET was up close and roused from between foes on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch weakened in the drive. GIN QUEEN showed speed and was a factor from the three path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was empty.
