MISS FRENCHIE dueled for the early lead while between foes, took charge on the turn, opened a gap and held sway to the wire in an off the rail drive. NABETHIAN had speed between foes to vie early, chased the leader into the stretch then proved second best while clear of the rest. HERE'S YA MAMA broke in the air, was well back, became a contender on the turn for home while going between foes and finished with a mild stretch rally. BARE LEGS stalked the leaders then had a belated wide bid. SLIPPER SLEW stalked a four horse duel into the turn but had no rally. MISS IDA BELLE dueled inside into the turn then faltered. REGAL SEN vied 4-wide into the turn then backed off and faded.
