EXCALIBUR showed speed, set the pace and with the lead through the stretch was kept to task. DEPUTY LOR had no speed, was roused from the inside on the far turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was up for place. CHARLEY TANGO was off the pace, moved up from the inside on the far turn and closed willingly through the stretch. JAZZ BOY stalked the leader, had a good position on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch faded late. CAN'T BE PETE hopped at the start, trailed on the far turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. ABERCROMBIEANDFISH was up close and chased on the far turn but tired in upper stretch. RED AND BOLD forced the pace and was roused from the three path on the far turn but came up empty.
