MANCINI'S MAN broke clear right from the gate, held sway throughout then was kept to task in an off the rail drive. FLEET STORM hustled up the inside of runners, chased the speed in to the stretch, could not close but was a clear second best. SIR WINZALOT off the pace then in the five path turning for home, had a late rally to nab the show spot. EXPLOSIVE GREEK settled off the pace on the turn, had a rail stretch run but came up short. CAPITAL OFFENSE tracked the leader early from off the rail then backed off and had no stretch bid. TOUGH MANCER chased the speed and then weakened in the drive and faded to last.
