GENTLE pressed the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was in hand at the top of the stretch and rallied on the rail. RARE SOLITAIRE was in touch, moved up on the far turn, lacked room at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. WEST COAST MISS set a pressured pace, had a slim lead at the top of the stretch and weakened late. SWEET THERAPY stalked the leaders, forced the pace on the far turn, vied at the top of the stretch and needed more. SHELF was in mid pack, roused on the far turn while in the four path and lacked a late response. SHEILA'S SNOWSHOE hopped at the start, was off the pace and had a mild gain while in the five path on the far turn but was it was not enough. LOVELY MISSY was back early, four path at the top of the stretch and was never a threat.
