CHRIS'S BAD BOY had three wide speed to press the pace, shook off challengers on the turn, went clear and was under mild urging to the wire. PARALLEL PAL had good early speed to vie for the lead, dueled with the winner on the turn then gave way but ran on to be second best. H. HAMMER G. unhurried and trailing the field early, had a mild wide stretch try but did not threaten the top two. SHOW ME THE MONTE close up early and in the game, stalked the speed duel then came up empty for the drive. SWEETY'S BOY on the inside and close early, failed to rally. GOT THAT SWING had inside speed to press the early pace then faded on the turn for home.
