DON'T SEND A BOY dueled from the outside, vied on the far turn and with the lead from the three path at the top of the stretch proved best. WESSIE THE CAT was in range, had a mild gain from the three path on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. WHISPERS PROMISE dueled from the inside, had the lead on the far turn and vied through the stretch but gave way late. NORTHERN MONARCH was in touch and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch lacked a rally. NAUGHTS NOT KNOTS was unhurried early, a factor from the inside on the far turn but lacked a late response. SHARONS PRINCE had no speed and showed little while never a threat. REASON AND RHYME was off the pace and trailed the field while never in contention.
