EL GRAYLING stalked the early leaders, forced the pace on the turn and with the lead from the six path at the top of the stretch proved best. SEVEN DAY FOOL set the pace, was pressured on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch was clearly second best. JIMMY CHEW SHOOS was in mid pack and raced evenly from the three path on the turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch needed more. STRIKE OIL was hustled early and roused from the inside on the turn but from the four path through the stretch evened out. NOT SO GRIEM had no speed, showed nothing and failed to fire. BOBBY BOUCHER was off slow and trailed the field throughout while never in contention.
