STAR PROSPECTOR set the pace, shook clear on the turn and from the three path through the stretch was much the best. ZENKO was unhurried early, roused from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was up for place. BEAR CHOCOLATED was in range and raced evenly from the inside on the turn but needed more. LET'S GO BEAR showed speed from the inside and was hustled along on the turn but tired in mid stretch. BUDDHA N' SMART was off the pace, showed little and from the five path through the stretch was never dangerous. AGAIN PLEASE was in touch but trailed on the turn and was never a threat.
