Footnotes

LOVE DESIGN was hustled early, vied on the turn, had the lead from the five path at the top of the stretch and fought gamely for the win. BE A BULL was in touch and a factor from the four path on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch just missed. BEST IN EGBERT was unhurried early and saved ground on the turn but needed more. DERAILED forced the pace and dueled from the inside on the turn but leveled off through the stretch. ALIMIN was in range and roused from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch had no response. DESTIND TO PAY was up close but chased from the inside on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch had no late kick. BULLET BOY stumbled just after the start and trailed the field throughout while outrun. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE RUN AFTER THE BREAK RESULTED IN DERAILED BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST FOR INTERFERENCE WITH BULLET BOY.
