STAKES H. A. Hindmarsh S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

For Fillies and Mares, Three-Year-Olds and Upward, those entered in the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale held in 2003 or earlier or which went through the sales ring as Yearlings in the 2002 or earlier Canadian Breeders Sales Autumn Yearling Sale and on which the maximum commission was paid, as specified in the conditions of the sale, shall be eligible for the H.A. Hindmarsh Stakes. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$900 when making entry, with \$75,000 Guaranteed. Three-Year-Olds 116 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2004 allowed 2 lbs. Of two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over in 2004 allowed 4 lbs. Of such a race in 2004 allowed 6 lbs.[No Canadian-bred allowance] The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given in the following order; 1) Horses which have finished first, second, third or fourth in a Sweepstakes. 2) In order of highest earnings at time of entry. Horses with equal earnings will draw for available positions. 3) Horses with no earnings will draw for remaining positions. Closed June 24 with 9 nominations. (C)

MISS GRINDSTONE chased the speed into the stretch then lacked the needed finish from inside the top two. MISS SANTA ANITA raced off the pace and did not menace with a late gain. PROSPECTIVE GAL had good speed, showed the way into the far turn then gave way to outside challengers.
