SOAR stalked the leader, was a factor from the inside on the turn and with the lead through the stretch just held. DARK CONTINENT was in range and hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch just missed. PRETTY PRETTY GIRL was in mid field and had a good position on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was all out. WIGGLE AND A WINK was unhurried early, moved up on the turn and with a bid from the three path at the top of the stretch evened out. SKIP THE NIGHT was up close and roused from the inside on the turn but had no response. MADAME ALI showed speed but was pressured on the turn and tired in upper stretch. SHEILA'S SNOWSHOE was well back, trailed the field on the turn and passed a tired foe through the stretch. GETTING BOLD was off the pace and raced in hand from the four path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch was outrun.
