**Footnotes**

CHERRY RING POP showed speed from between foes, had a slim lead on the turn and with pressure at the top of the stretch prevailed. JAMPERA was in range, gained ground on the turn and from the six path through the stretch was up for place. BEEJAYKAY was in touch, raced evenly from the inside on the turn and with a mild bid through the stretch had a good effort. WILDA showed speed and was a factor on the turn but from the three path through the stretch evened out. TREVI FOUNTAIN was back early and had a mild gain from the three path on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch needed more. BOLD DASH stalked the leaders and was a factor on the turn but from the five path through the stretch leveled off. TOUCH THIS was off the pace and had a mild gain on the turn but from the six path through the stretch was not a factor. GOLDEN GILDA was in mid pack and hustled along on the turn but had no response. L. T.'S GIRL was off slow, trailed the field on the turn but passed tired foes through the stretch. FUTURE CUPID was in mid field and showed little with no impact. ALKES GAL had no speed and showed nothing while never in contention. GUARANTEED ISSUE was hustled from the outside but lost ground on the turn and was empty.
