Footnotes

CHRISTO was unhurried early, moved up while in the four path on the far turn, six path at the top of the stretch and was all out in the drive. RED LAKE GOLD was in touch, lost ground on the backstretch, angled out to the five path at the top of the stretch and rallied. DERBY FOX was in range, saved ground on the far turn, had an inside bid through the stretch but was outfinished. BEAR'S PRADO stalked the leader, vied from the four path at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. DEPUTY LOR was off the pace, roused while inside on the far turn, had a bid at the top of the stretch but needed more. MALIBU MONSTER trailed the field, had a mild gain on the far turn and lacked a late response. MIGHTY SILVER set the pace, led on the far turn, vied at the top of the stretch and flattened out.
