GRAIN OF TRUTH dueled outside, vied on the turn, led while in the four path at the top of the stretch and proved best. CAYMAN PEACH was off the pace, gained ground on the turn while in the three path, five path at the top of the stretch and just missed. NESSUN DORMA was back early, had a mild gain from the four path on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and finished well. TAGS AND TOWEL was unhurried early, roused from the three path on the turn and closed belatedly. CENT T MINT trailed, saved ground on the turn, angled out in the stretch and passed tired foes. AFLEET'S LOVE SONG was in range, chased between foes on the turn and flattened out late in the drive. JUST LIKE PERRY dueled inside, had a slim lead into the turn and tired in upper stretch. PARISIAN JADE was in touch, a factor on the turn and gave way in the stretch..
